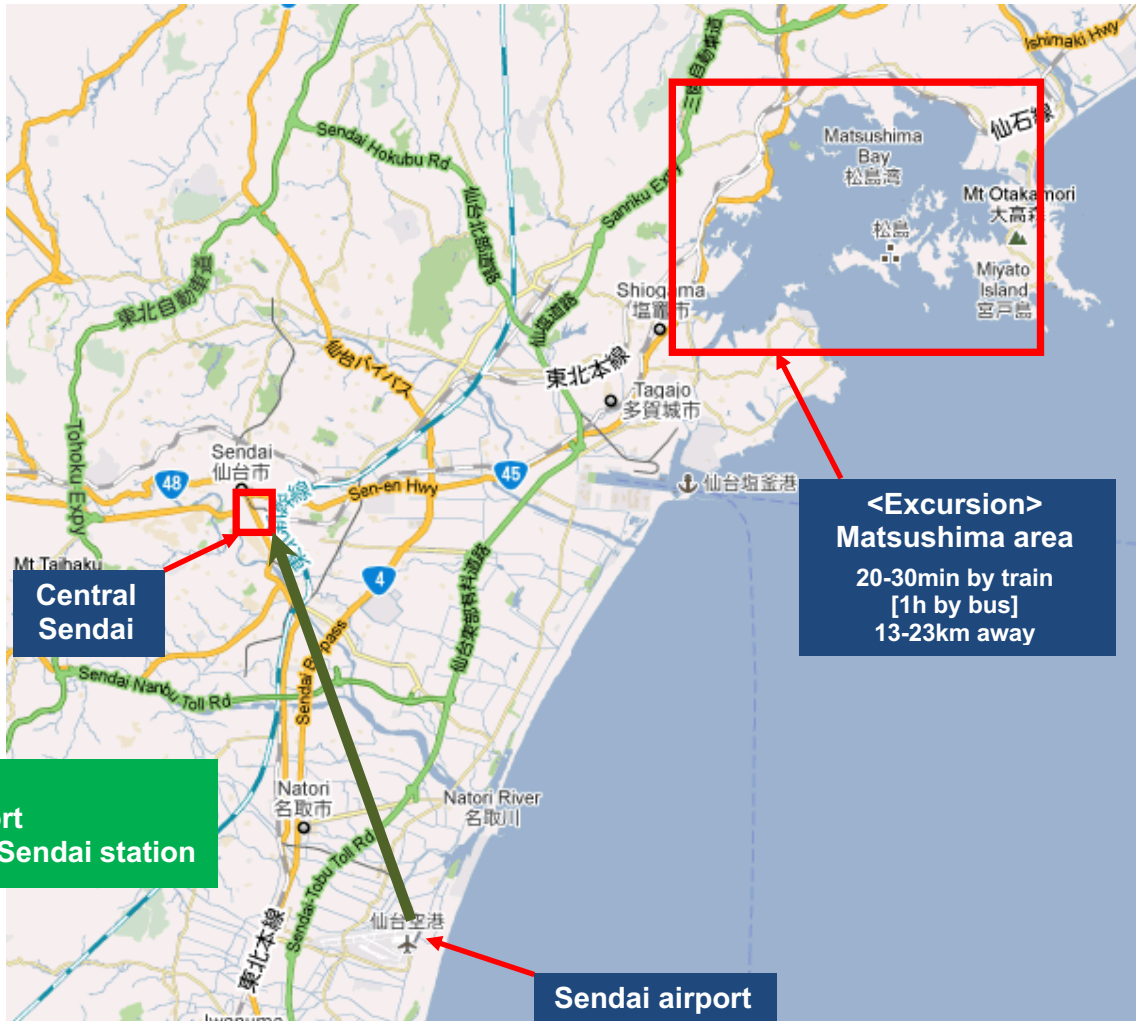
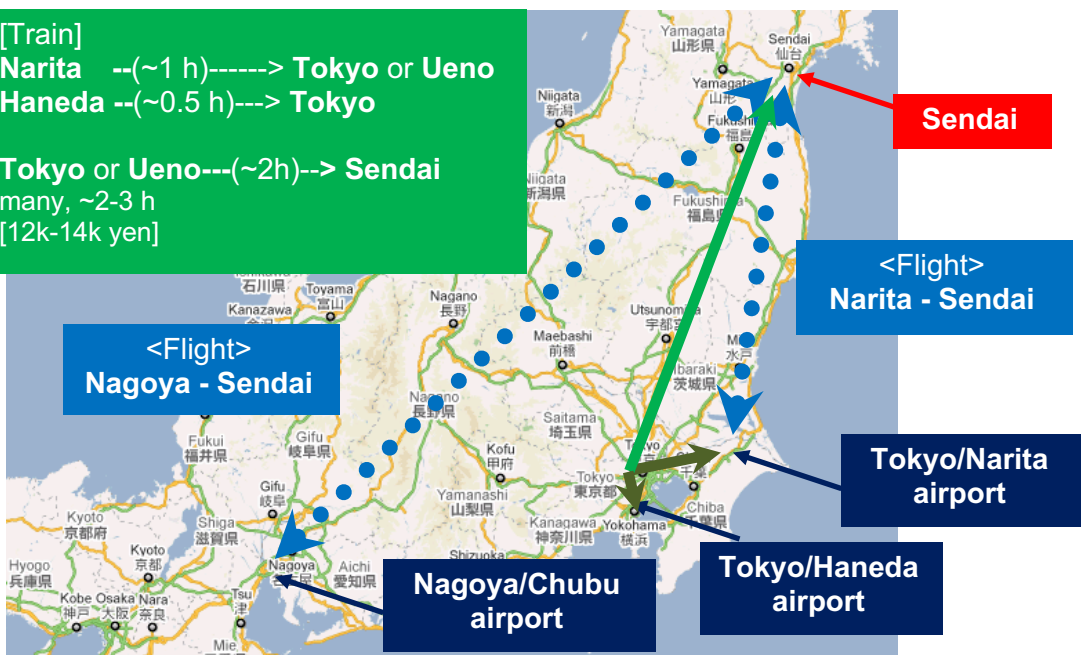


**** Access to Sendai ****



[Train]
 Narita --(~1 h)-----> Tokyo or Ueno
 Haneda --(~0.5 h)----> Tokyo
 Tokyo or Ueno---(~2h)--> Sendai
 many, ~2-3 h

<Arrival at Sendai by flight>

- * **Tokyo/Narita airport -- Sendai airport (~ 1h)**
 - * **Nagoya/Chubu airport -- Sendai airport (~1 h)**

[Train] **Sendai airport -- Sendai station** [30min] (650yen)
All trains are bound to Sendai station.

<Arrival at Tokyo airports: Tokyo / Ueno station → Sendai station by train>

- * **Tokyo/Narita airport – Tokyo or Ueno station (3-ways)**

[Train: JR Narita Express (NEX)] **Narita airport – Tokyo station** [60min]

[Train: Keisei Skyliner] **Narita airport – Ueno station** [50min]

[Train: Keisei Skyliner] **Narita airport – Nippori station** [50min]

[Train: JR Yamate-line] **Nippori station – Ueno station** [5min]

- * **Tokyo/Haneda station – Tokyo station (2-ways)**

[Monorail] **Haneda airport – Hamamatsu-Cho station** [20min]

[Train: JR Yamate-line] **-- Tokyo station** [10min]

or

[Train: Keikyu] **Haneda airport – Shinagawa station** [25min]

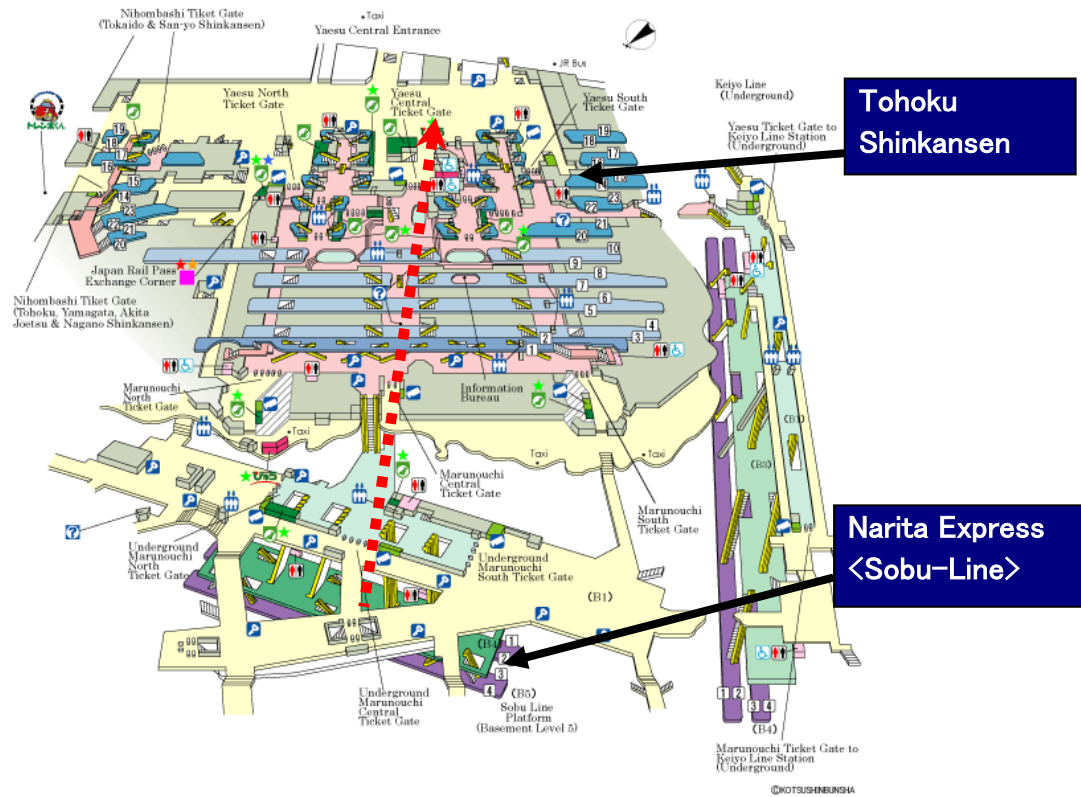
[Train: JR Yamate-line] **-- Tokyo station** [10min]

[Train: JR Tohoku Shinkansen] **Tokyo or Ueno > Sendai** [100-120min]
